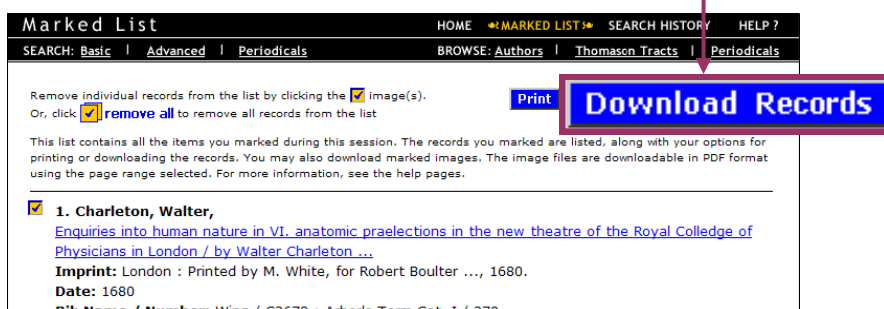

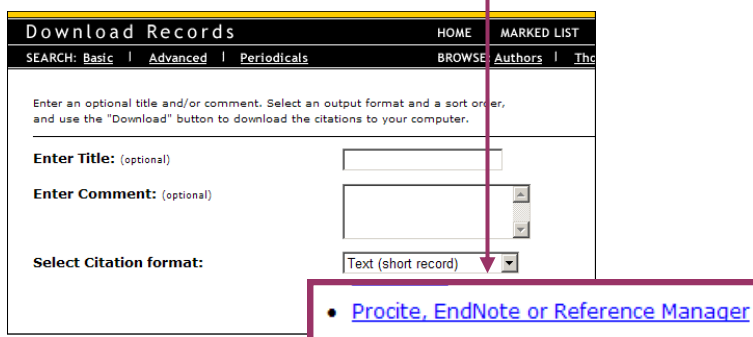

Direct export the results to Endnote

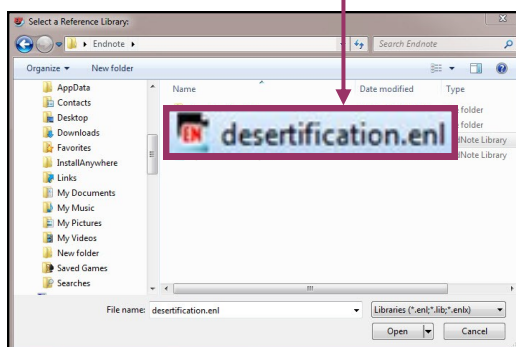
- 1 Once the list of marked records is displayed, click on **Download Records**.



- 2 Click on **Procite, EndNote or Reference Manager** for **Direct Export**.

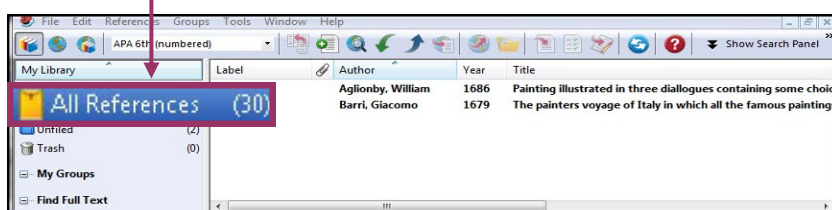


- 3 Locate your Endnote library and click on **Open**.
