Enter a search statement in Literature Online e.g. > A tale of two cities

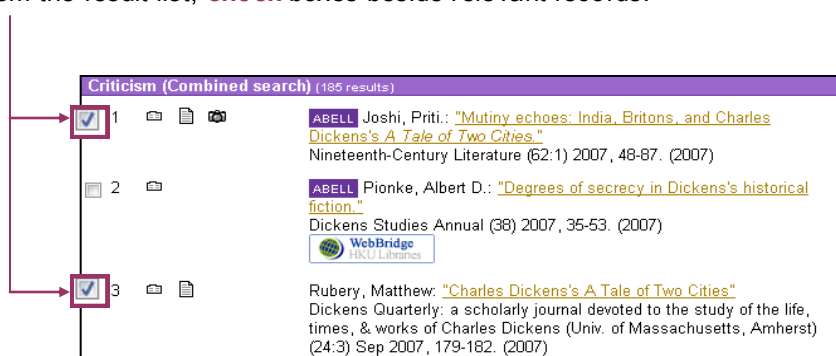

Click on Go.

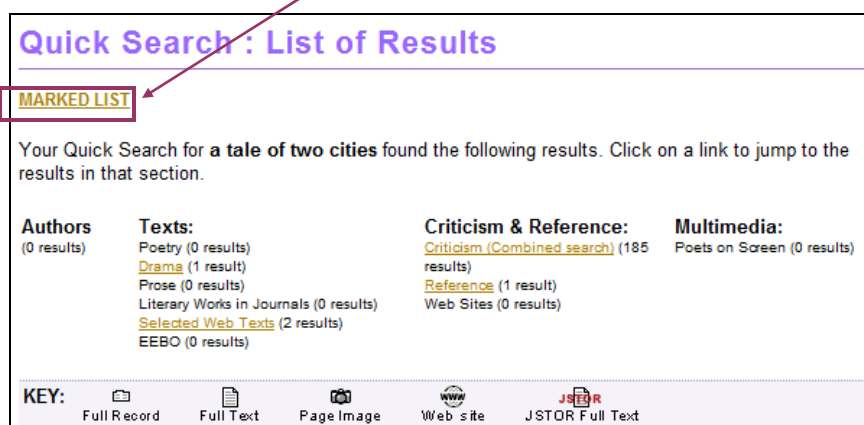
