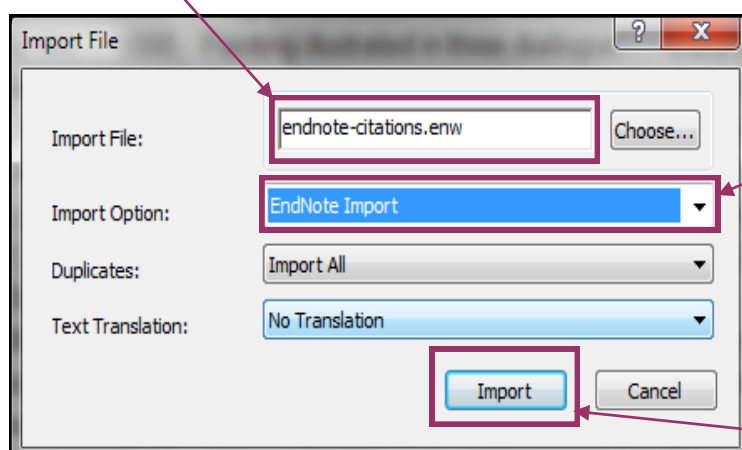

- 2 Select the **enw file** that you have saved just now.

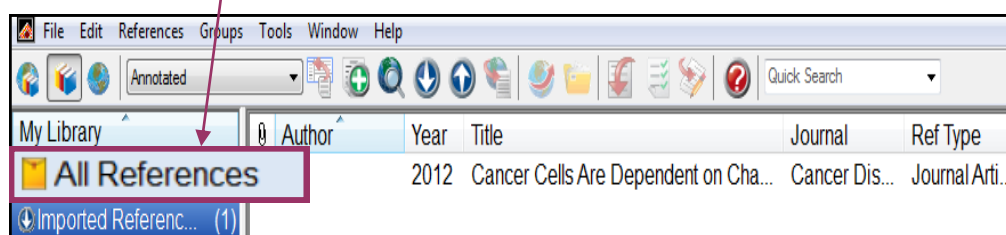


- 3 Select **EndNote Import** as the import option.
