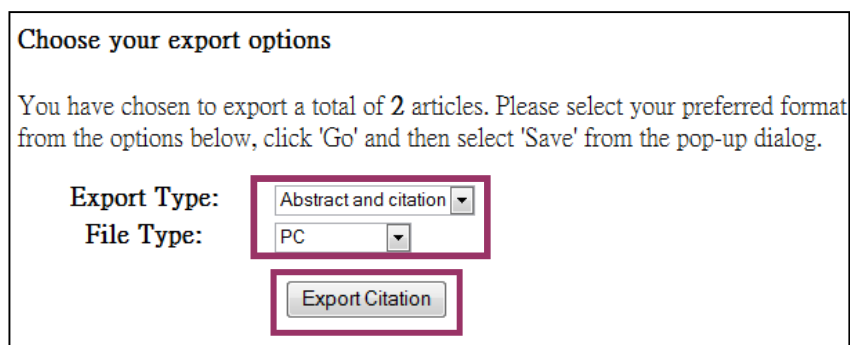

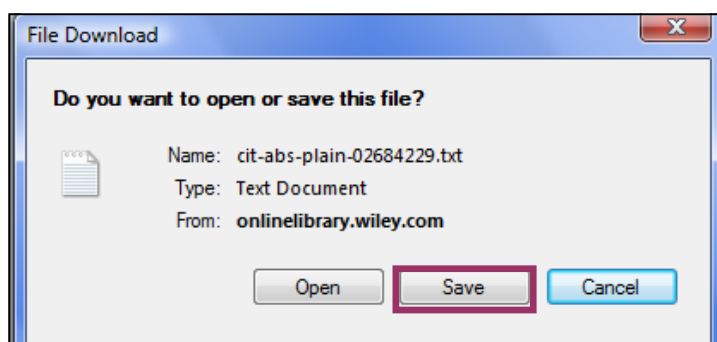

Save the results to a txt file

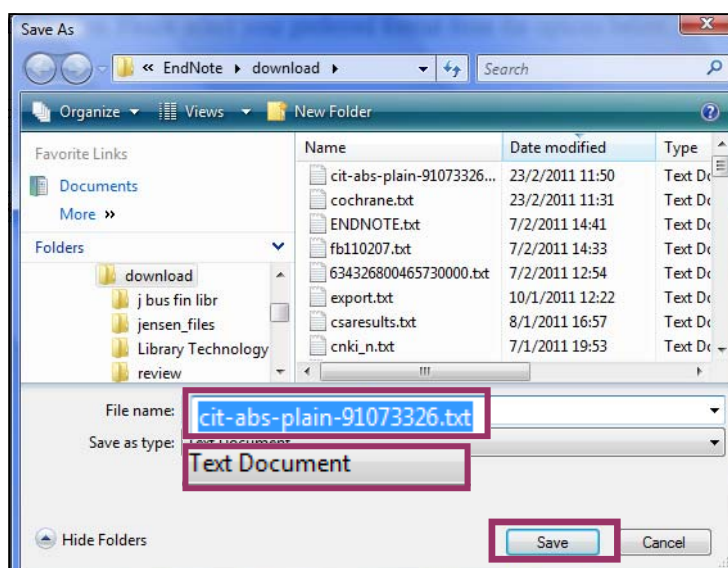
- 1 In **Choose your export options** window, select the preferred format from the options provided, then click on **Export Citation**.



- 2 When prompted to save your file. Click on **Save**.



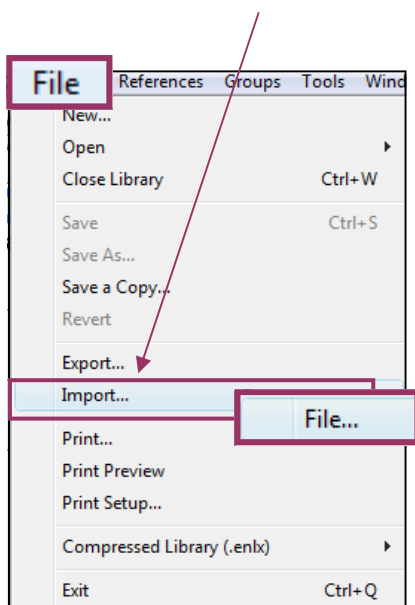
- 3 You will be prompted to save the text file. Change the filename if needed. Then click on **Save**.



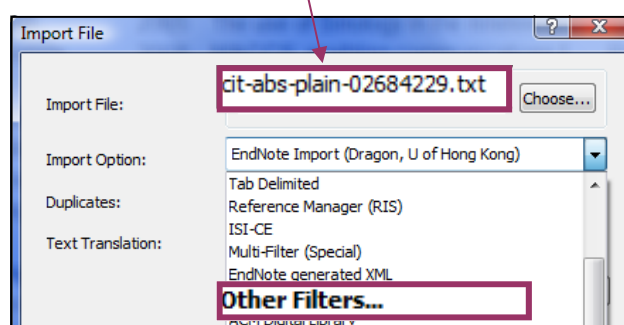

Import to Endnote

- 1 Open the Endnote library, e.g. *guide.enl*, that you would like to import the records to. Then select **Import** from the top bar menu: **File > Import > File**



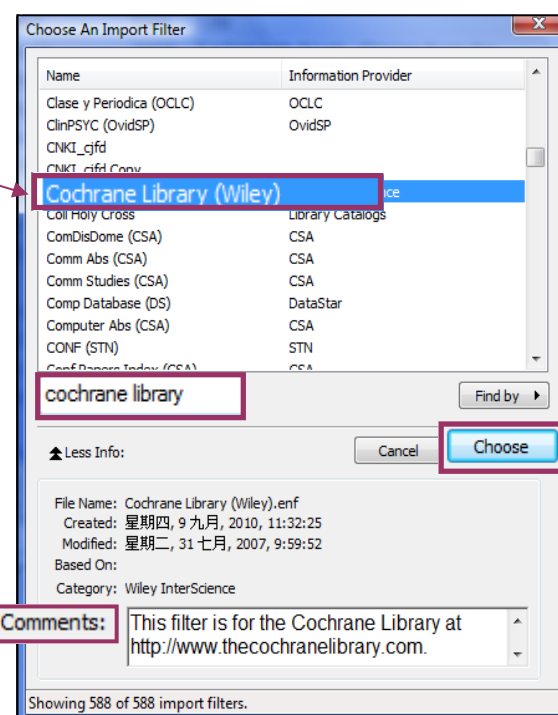
- 2 Choose the **txt** file that you have saved just now.



- 3 Choose the appropriate filter. If **Cochrane Library** is not on the list, select **Other Filters**.

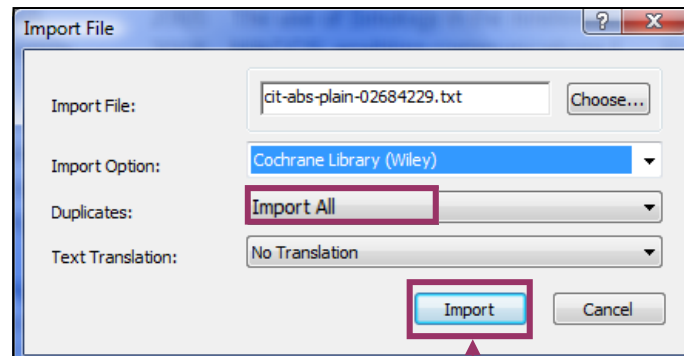
Locate **Cochrane Library** from the list or type in **Cochrane Library** in the search box and press **Enter** to locate an appropriate filter.

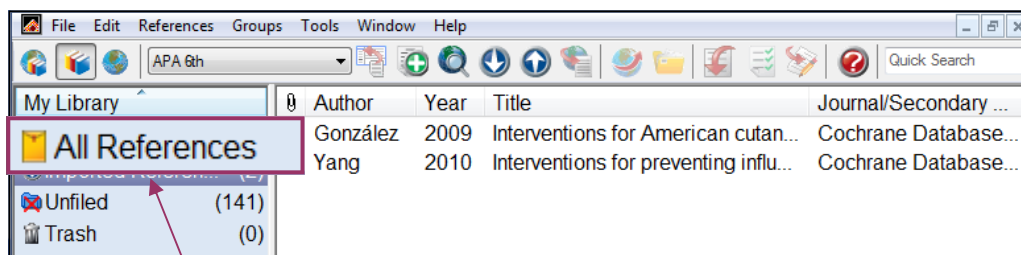
Read the **Comments** to find out the downloading instructions for this filter. Then click on **Choose**.

- 6 Select **Import All**.
Note: To remove identical records, select **Discard Duplicates**.



- 7 Once all the options have been selected, click on **Import**.

- 8 The records will be duly imported into the selected Endnote library.



- 9 Click on **All References** to show all references in your library.
