

Once all records are marked, click on Marked List at the top of the page.







In Download options, Select Download in a format compatible with ProCite, EndNote, Reference Manager and RefWorks.








Open the Endnote library, e.g. *guide.enl*, that you would like to import the records to. Then select **Import** from the top bar menu: **File** > **Import** 






The records will be duly imported into the selected Endnote library.
