

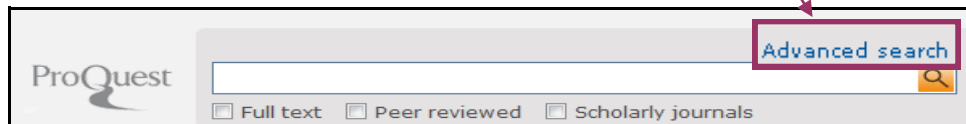

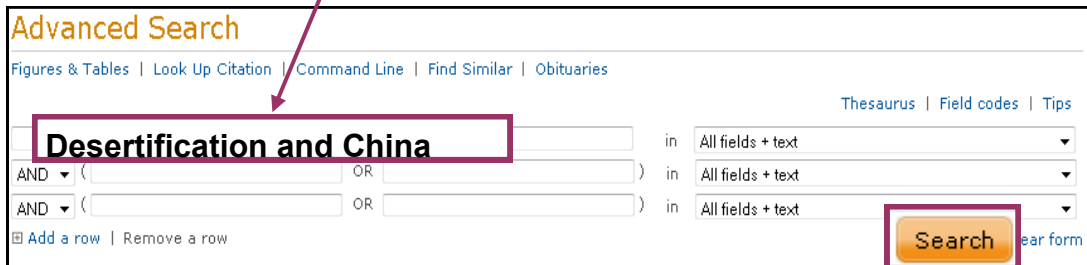
Go to Proquest and retrieve your results

Select **Advanced Search** in ProQuest.



Enter a **search statement** e.g. *Desertification and China*.

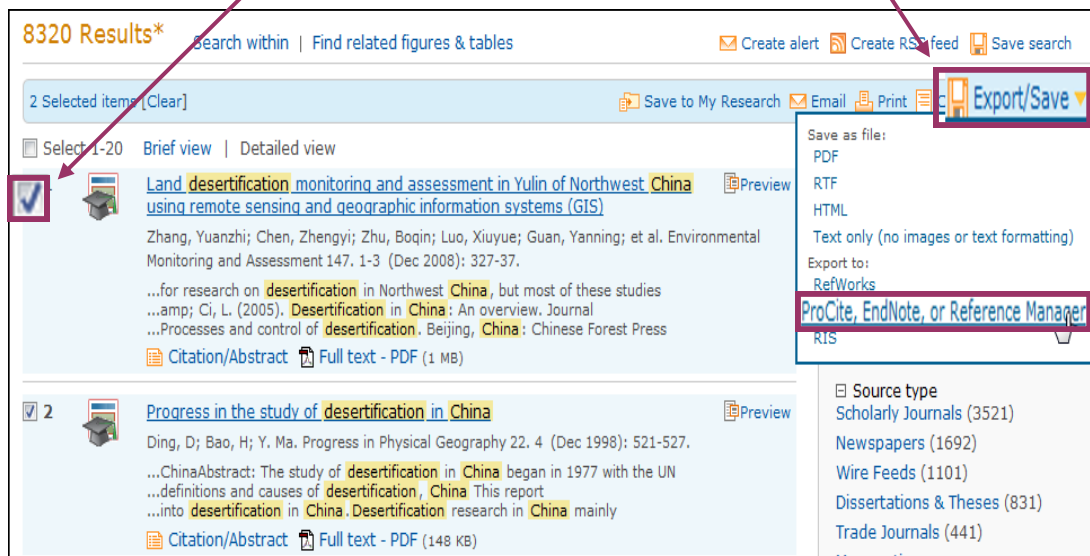
Click on **Search**.

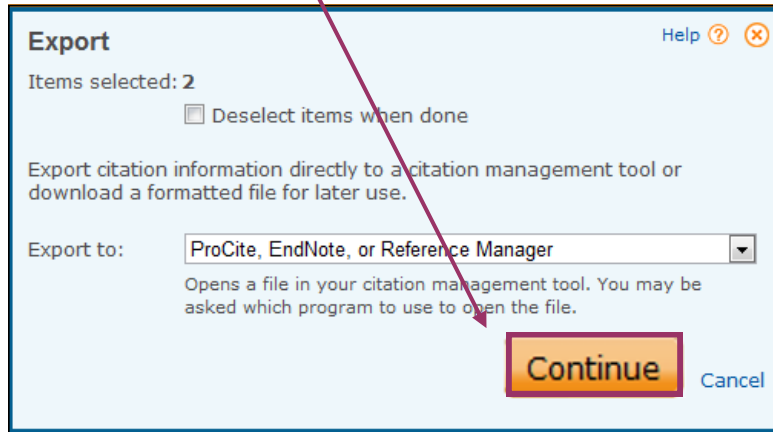
Once all records have been checked, click on **Export/Save** and then select **ProCite, EndNote, or Reference Manager**.



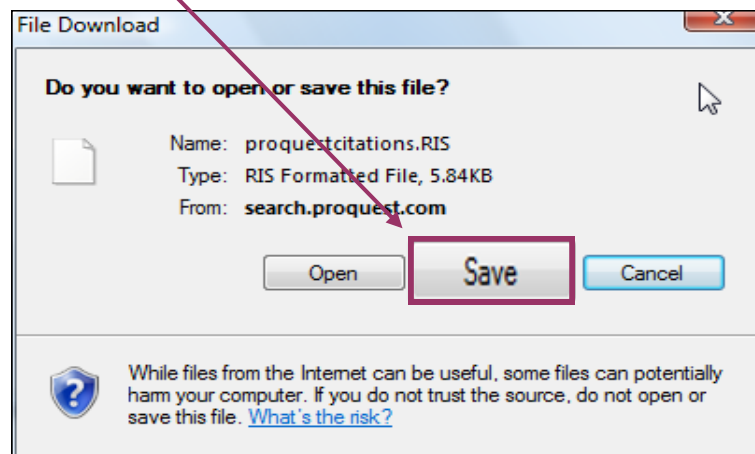

### Save the results to Endnote

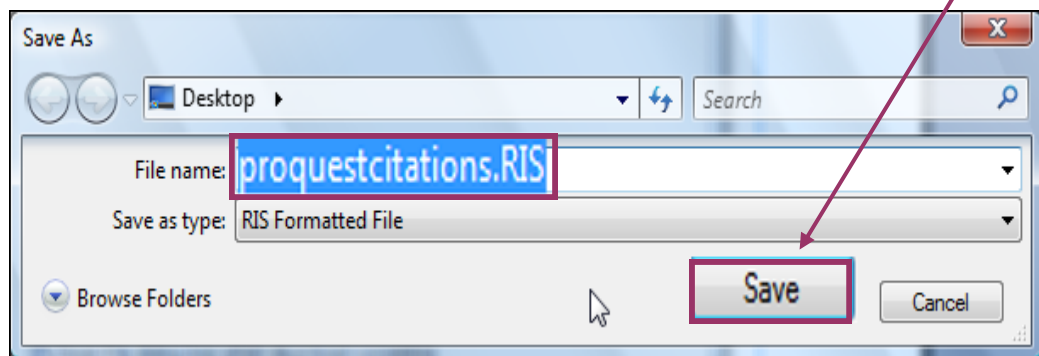
1 Click on **Continue**.



2 Click on **Save**.



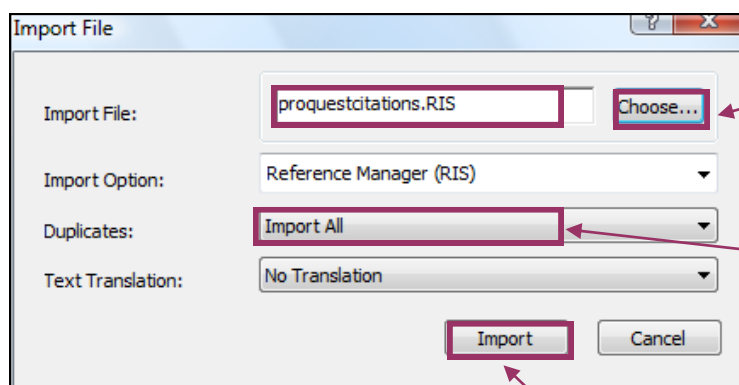
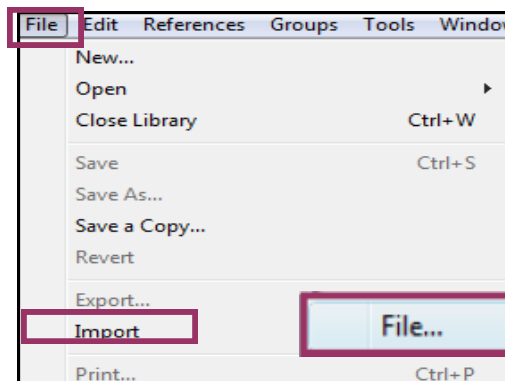
3 Click on **Save**.

## Import to Endnote

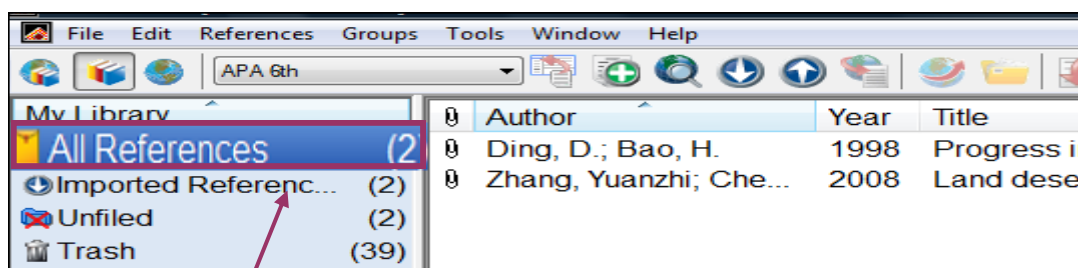
- 1 **Open** the Endnote library, e.g. *desertification.enl*, that you would like to import the records to. Then select from the top bar menu: **File > Import > File...**



- 2 Choose the **RIS** file saved.
- 3 Select **Import All**. Note: To remove identical records, select **Discard Duplicates**.

- 4 Once all the options have been selected, click on **Import**.

- 5 The records will be duly imported into the selected Endnote library.



- 6 Click on **All References** under **Groups** to show all references in your library.
