Go to Wiley Online Library and retrieve your results

- 1 Click on **Advanced search** in Wiley Online Library.

- 2 Enter a **search statement** to search e.g. > *desertification and China*.

- 3 Click on **Search**.

- 4 From the result list, **check** those which you consider as relevant.

- 5 Then click on **Export Citation**.

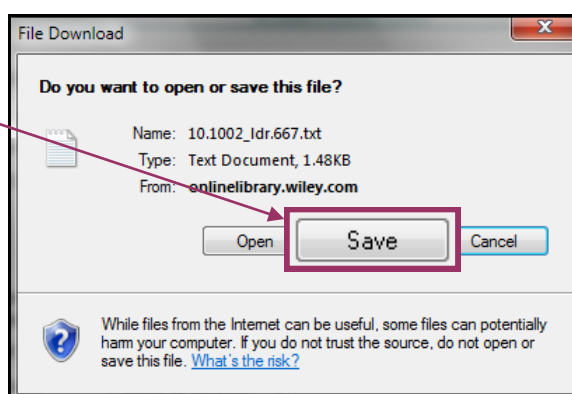

Save the results to a txt file

- 1 In Export Citation, select **Plain Text** as format.

- 2 Click on **Submit**.

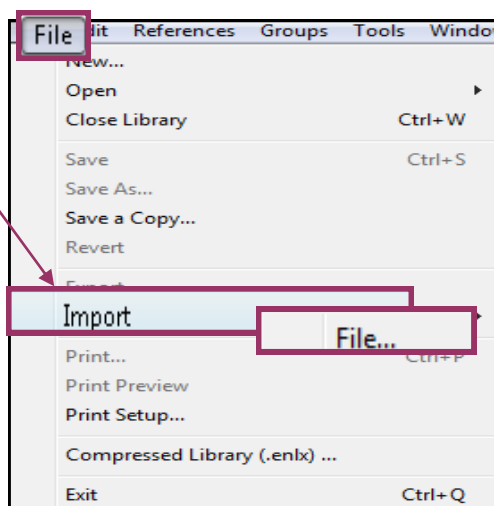
- 3** You will be prompted to **Save** the file.

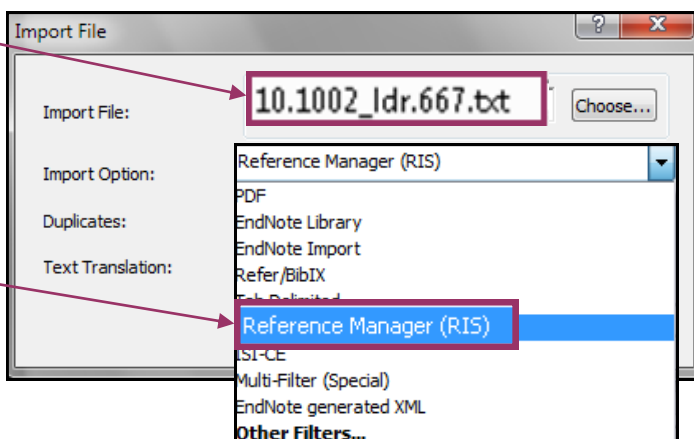
Import to Endnote

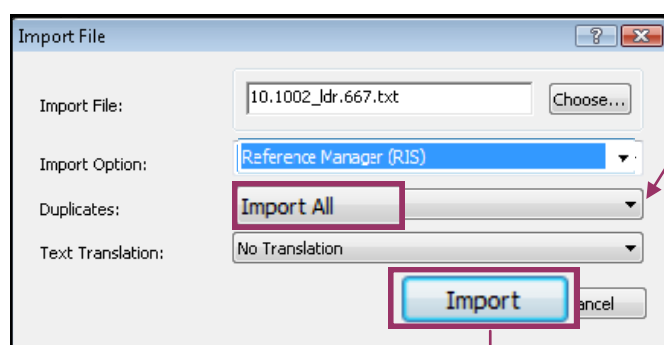
- 1** **Open** the Endnote library to import the txt file to Endnote. Select **Import** from the top bar menu: **File > Import > File**.



- 2** Select the **txt file** that you have saved just now.

- 3** Choose **Reference Manager (RIS)** as the import option.

Select **Import All**.
Note: To remove identical records, select **Discard Duplicates**

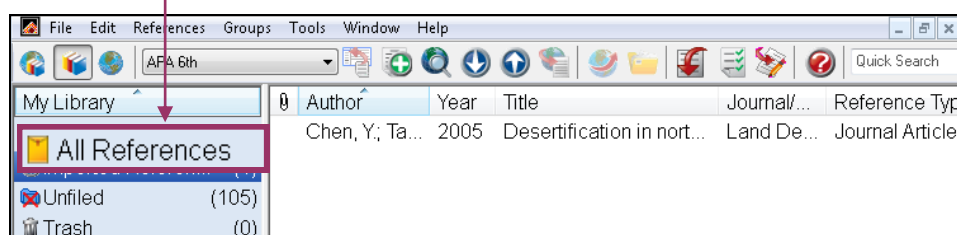
Once all the options have been selected, click on **Import**.

The records will be duly imported into the selected Endnote library.

Click on **All References** to show all references in your library.
