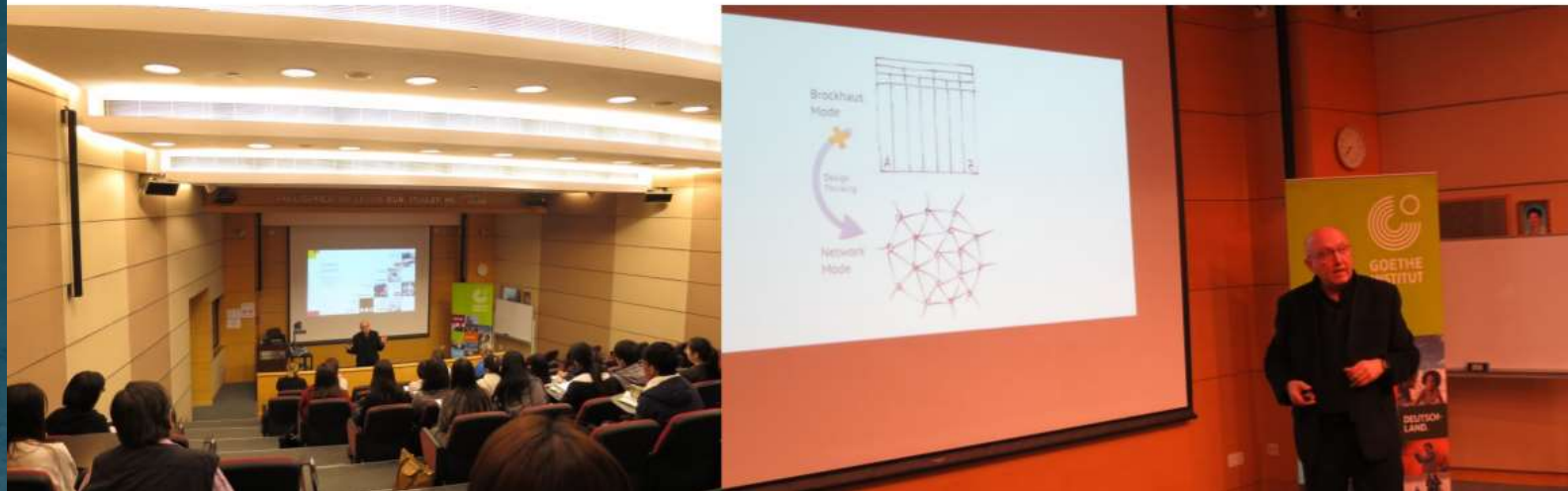

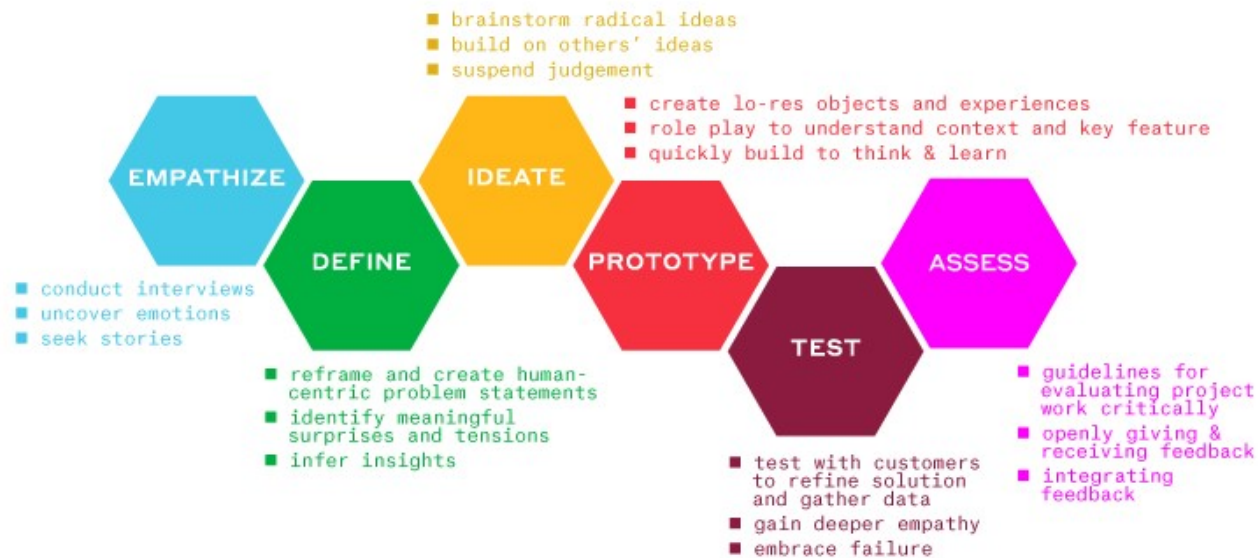

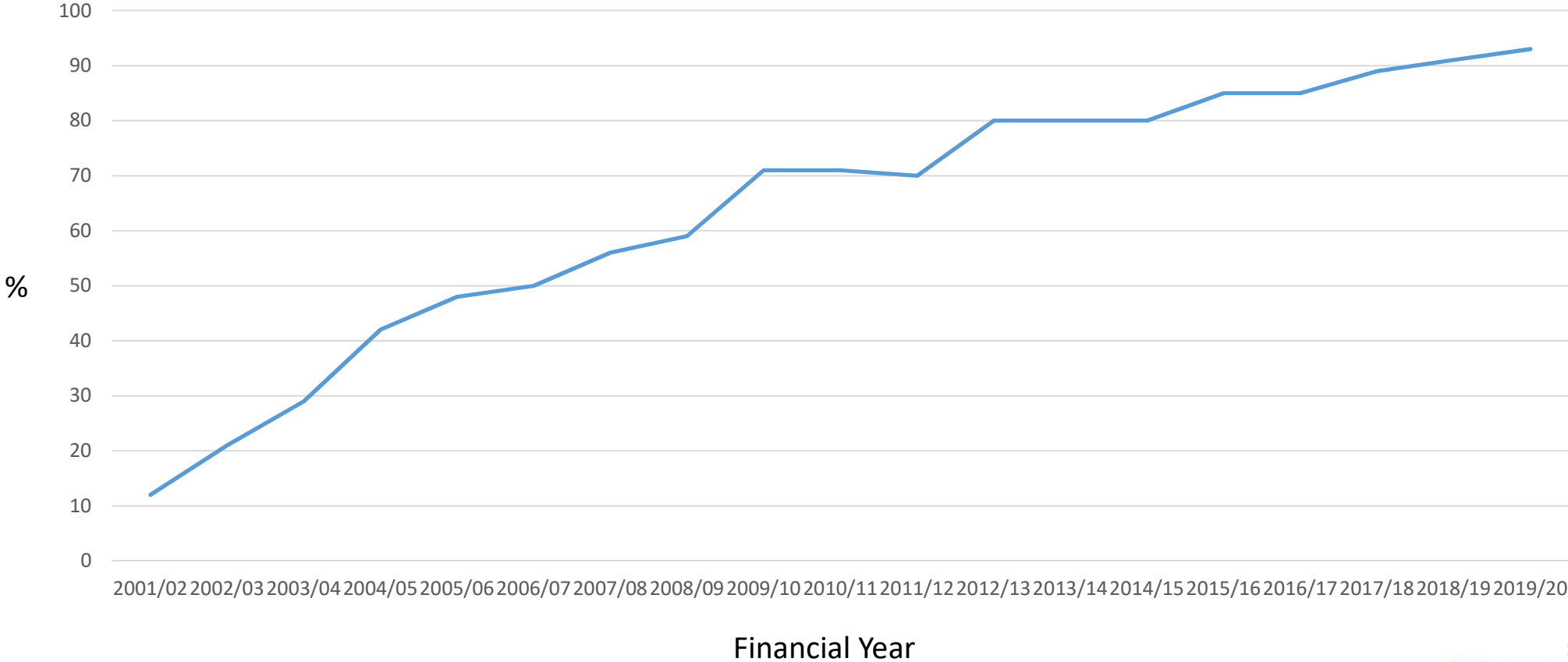

HKU Sustainability Report – What the Libraries have done?

- Since 2015, **duplicate copies** not used for 6 years or low usage print journals with e-version available have been **relegated to Xiamen University Malaysia Campus**.
- Two **express scanners** installed in the Main Library in 2014 and 2016. Up to October 2020, over 1.1 million pages were scanned by the devices, equating to a monthly average of 16K pages.
- Discounted rates for **duplex printing** since September 2015.
- More **online registration forms** and online **library surveys**.
- Encourage patrons to fill their reusable bottles at **water dispensers** as part of the Ditch Disposable campaign since December 2017

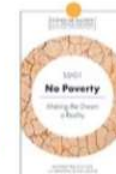

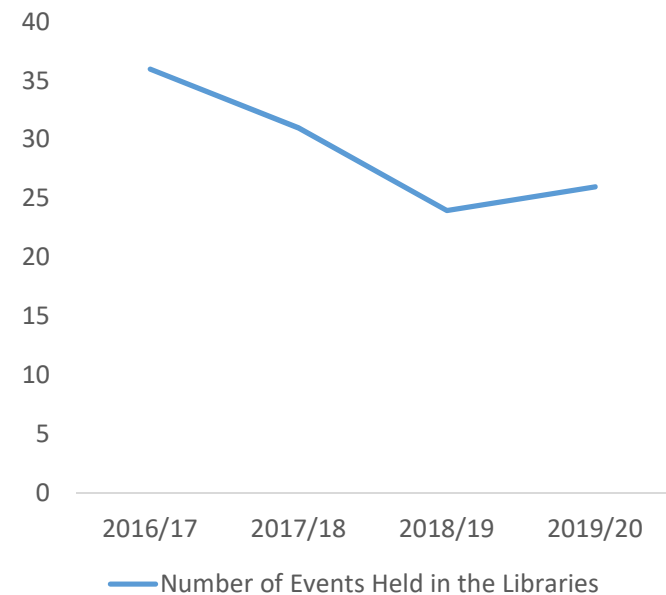

UN SDG Profile of University of Hong Kong (HKU)

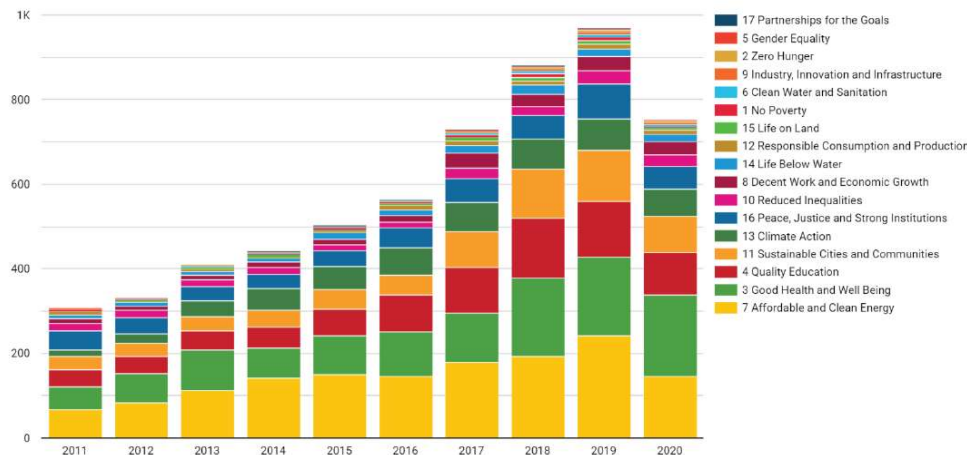


