


Design Thinking Process Diagram*



HKU Sustainability Report – What the Libraries have done?

- Since 2015, duplicate copies not used for 6 years or low usage print journals with e-version available have been relegated to Xiamen University Malaysia Campus.
- Two express scanners installed in the Main Library in 2014 and 2016.
 Up to October 2020, over 1.1 million pages were scanned by the devices, equating to a monthly average of 16K pages.
- Discounted rates for **duplex printing** since September 2015.
- More online registration forms and online library surveys.
- Encourage patrons to fill their reusable bottles at water dispensers as part of the Ditch Disposable campaign since December 2017












SDG Profile of HKU


Digital Science reported only 10% of research output relates to the SDG impact
