


Hong Kong is an associate member of the UN:

Active Role of hosting and convening UN related events







Some progress, but...

"The North-East Asian subregion has made relatively good progress in achieving SDGs 1 to 9 compared with goals from 10 to 16, according to the Asia and the Pacific SDG Progress Report 2020. North-East Asia is on track or made significant progress on no poverty (Goal 1), zero hunger (Goal 2), good health and well-being (Goal 3) and quality education (Goal 4) as well as clean water and sanitation (Goal 6), affordable and clean energy (Goal 7), decent work and economic growth (Goal 8), and industry, innovation and infrastructure (Goal 9). On the other hand, the subregion needs to further intensify progress being made in income equality, women empowerment, renewable energy, marine protected areas, forest coverage, etc., and make spillover effects in their relevant SDGs in the Decade of Action for accelerating SDGs, starting from 2020."


Global Knowledge Sharing on UN 2030 Goals






